Habitat/environmental sensitivity: Forested wetland

Although removed from the List of Endangered and Threatened Species, it continues to be protected under the MBTA and BGEP (see consultation memo for more information).

Cultural/historical resources: Not known at this time.

Oyster habitat: None in this area.

State/federal/tribal lands: ESI 109 does not indicate any state, federal or tribal lands.
