Summary and Conclusions of Environmental Review:

Habitat/environmental sensitivity: Waterway is surrounded by brackish marsh. Limit travel to open water to avoid impacts. Waterway is also is part of the Calcasieu ship channel and subject to high volume of vessel traffic (much for refinery products). Exercise caution while operating in waterway.

Threatened/endangered species: None located in waterway.

Cultural/historical resources: No known resources at this time. Further review not necessary.

Oyster habitat: None in waterway.

State/federal/tribal lands: None appear in the survey area.
