Summary and Conclusions of Environmental Review:

Habitat/environmental sensitivity: Aerial imagery indicate that forested riverine habitat dominate the shorelines of the subject waterway.

Threatened/endangered species: ESI maps do not indicate the presence of any Federally-designated Threatened or Endangered species within the waterway.

Cultural/historical resources: No known resources at this time.

Oyster habitat: No oyster leases occur within this waterway.

State/federal/tribal lands: The Sabine Island Wildlife Management Area (WMA) occurs along the west bank of the lower reaches of the waterway. Contact the Sabine Island WMA Manager to notify/coordinate prior to any removal operations along that portion of shoreline, (337) 491-2576.
