**Summary and Conclusions of Environmental Review:**

Habitat/environmental sensitivity: The waterway is surrounded primarily by development with a few areas containing forested wetland.

Threatened/endangered species: Lafourche Parish is known to be inhabited by nesting bald eagles. Although removed from the List of Endangered and Threatened Species, it continues to be protected under the MBTA and BGEP (see consultation memo for more information).

Cultural/historical resources: None known at this time.

Oyster habitat: None
